Description			
<i>Provide a short description of the event and its activities.</i>			
The workshop on January 20, 2023 tested the educational materials developed in the project " RESIST - For Human Rights. Learning materials on the resistance against National Socialism in Europe using the example of France and Germany 1933-1945 ". The students had the opportunity to test the materials and give initial feedback to the project team. In open tasks, the students got to know the biographies on the basis of sources provided and dealt with motives as well as forms of resistance			

against National Socialism and the Vichy regime. The students were able to adopt both a French and a comparative German and European perspective.

The workshop was done with one class (last grade of secondary school), with students aged 14. First, the students visited the memorial, on wednesday, the 11<sup>th</sup> of january 2023. With a guided-tour of 1h30, they discovered the history of the place : how this former jail was used during the Second world war, by the Vichy regime, to lock political opponents and resisters and then by German authorities, to intern Jews, resisters, hostages before deportation and executions.

The workshop was done in a second time, directly at the school, thursday the 2<sup>nd</sup> of february 2023. With a cultural mediator of the memorial, during 2h, students worked in 5 groups, on 2 biographies: one french and one german resister. Thanks to a questionnaire, they searched informations in the documents, in order to understand better resisters' life and commitment. The goal was to underline similarities and / or differences between biographies to understand how the context can impact people choices, their actions and the way they do it. This work was done in autonomy. At the end, a common synthesis was done, for all the students to have a global overview of the biographies. The cultural mediator used a power-point with additional artwork and references to help students, if they want to go further with the subject, on their own.
