Description

Provide a short description of the event and its activities.

The first event took place on January 16, 2024 with master students who will become teachers in schools (in social science and civic education) or multipliers in non-formal education soon. The multiplier event was thematically linked to a seminar that the students attend. This seminar is about concepts of citizenship and civic education. They therefore had a high level of interest and motivation to use our material in their future work. Through a presentation, the participants were introduced to the general idea of the project, its didactic-methodical background, and projects results. In order to better understand the added value of the materials, we offered an implementation simulation as part of the multiplier event, allowing participants to explore the materials from the learner's perspective. The experience was then discussed in a plenary session before switching to the teachers' perspective. Possible areas of application and procedures were discussed with the seminar participants. The feedback of the participants on our materials was very positive.

The second event took place on February 23, 2024 at the Volkshochschule Hannover. Under the title "Democracy and human rights education - impulses from current transfer projects in political education", political educators, teachers, interested multipliers and stakeholders were invited to familiarise themselves with the RESIST project. At the beginning, current questions on the state of democracy and the field of education were discussed in small groups and in plenary sessions. The answers given by the participants from a variety of educational contexts led to the RESIST project. After a general presentation of the project, the participants were able to explore the didactic background and materials of the project in greater depth at different stations. Project staff were present at each station to moderate the dialogue and provide further information and answers to questions. After an intensive exchange, the impressions, ideas and further questions about the project were again discussed in small groups and then in plenary. The event ended with a reference back to the initial questions in connection with the RESIST project. Here too, the feedback was very positive and the participants were all motivated to use the materials from the project in their own work.
